

New Delhi, the 30th January, 2003

G.S.R. 71.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Professor (Biochemistry), Reader (Biochemistry) and Senior Lecturer (Biochemistry) in the Government Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Government Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh, Professor (Biochemistry), Reader (Biochemistry) and Senior Lecturer (Biochemistry), (Group 'A' Gazetted Posts) Recruitment Rules, 2002.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. These rules shall apply to the posts as specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.—The number of the said posts, their classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (14) of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification.—No person,—

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing, and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Savings.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time, in this regard.

- ii. The Departmental Officer in the grade of Reader with two years regular service in the grade will also be considered alongwith outsiders. In case he/she is selected for appointment to the post, the same shall be deemed to have been filled by promotion.

The Departmental Officer in the feeder category who are in the direct line of promotion shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment on deputation. Similarly, deputationists shall not be eligible for consideration for appointment by promotion.
