Notification

The 15th February, 2018

No. 455/FII(6)/2018/2084.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, S.O. No. 3267; dated 1st November, 1966, the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment of the post of Director Principal (Group 'A') in Government Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh under the Department of Medical Education and Research, Chandigarh Administration, namely :—

1. (i) **Short title and commencement.**—These rules may be called the Government Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh, Director Principal Group 'A' (Non-Ministerial) Post Recruitment Rules, 2018.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Chandigarh Administration Gazette.

2. **Application.**—These rules shall apply to the post specified in column 1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.**—The number of posts, their classification and the scales of pay shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.**—The method of recruitment to the said post, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

5. **Disqualification.**—No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living ;

Or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage, with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post ;

Provided that the Administrator, Union Territory of Chandigarh may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt, any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.**—Where the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, New Delhi relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Savings.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Caste, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Chandigarh Administration from time to time in this regard.
