## Notification

**G.S.R. 50752.**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India, read with Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, the President of India makes the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment of Group 'A' post i.e. Biochemist (Non-Ministerial) in the Government Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh, namely :—

1. **Short title and Commencement.**—(1) These rules may be called the Government Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh, Biochemist (Group 'A' Non- Gazetted) (Non-Ministerial Post) Recruitment Rules, 2019.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. These rules shall apply to the post as specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Number of posts, classification and scale of pay.**—The number of the said post, its classification and the scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said schedule.

4. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.**—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

5. **Disqualification.**—No person,—

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
- (b) who having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post :

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.**—Where the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. **Savings.**—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Caste, the Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
