Sir,

I am directed to refer to Medical Council of India letter No. MCI-37(1)(Recog-9)(UG)/2017 Med./176338 dated 28.02.2018 on the subject mentioned above and to convey the approval of the Central Government to the recommendation of Medical Council of India for recognition of the MBBS degree awarded by the Punjab University, Chandigarh when granted on or after December 2017 for increased number of seats from 50 to 100 in respect of the students of Govt. Medical College & Hospital, Chandigarh.

2. The recognition so granted to an Undergraduate Course for award of MBBS degree shall be for a maximum period of 5 years, upon which it shall have to be renewed. The procedure for 'Renewal' of recognition shall be same as applicable for the award of recognition. Failure to see timely renewal of recognition shall invariably result in stoppage of admissions to the concerned Undergraduate Course of MBBS at the said institute/Medical College.
