No. 2025/15404.—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution of India read with the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification S.O. No. 3267, dated 1st November, 1966, the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh is pleased to make the following rules, regulating the method of recruitment to Group 'B' posts i.e. Nursing Officer (Non-Ministerial) in the Government Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh, namely:

- 1. **Short title and commencement:- (i)** These rules may be called the Government Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh (Group-B) (Non-Ministerial) Recruitment Rules, 2025.
- (ii) These rules came into force from the approval of UPSC i.e., 20.02.2025

2. Application:

These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column No.1 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of posts, classification and scale of pay:-

The number of posts, their classification and the scales of pay shall be as specified in columns 2 to 4 of the said Schedule.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit and qualification, etc:-

The method of recruitment to the said posts, age limit, qualifications and other matters connected therewith shall be as specified in columns 5 to 13 of the said Schedule.

5. Disqualification: No person:

- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; OR
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage, with any person, shall be eligible for the appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Administrator, Union Territory of Chandigarh may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal Law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing, exempt, any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax:-Where the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, he may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with UPSC, relax any of the provisions of these rules in respect of any class or category of persons.

7. Savings:-

Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, Ex-Servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by Central Government from time to time in this regard.

8. **Repeal:-**

The Government Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh (Group-C), Recruitment Rules, 2002 notified vide notification no. 17174, dated 06.06.2002, further amended vide notification no. 1641/FII(6)/2011/9838, dated 21.11.2011, notification no. GMCH/1EA2/12(5)23/2018/30674 dated 25.07.2018 and notification no. 14355 dated 13.03.2020 in respect of the post of Staff Nurse only are hereby repealed.
