

2.	Submission of Online applications for Fresh & scholarship by students (Post Matric).	15 th July, 2019 to 31 st October, 2019
3.	Submission of Online applications for Fresh scholarship by students (Top Class).	

The major Conditions of eligibility for filling up of online application can be seen at www.disabilityaffairs.gov.in and FAQs with regards to Time-Line /various activities relating to submission of application form can be seen on the NSP homepage of the website i.e. www.scholarships.gov.in

The eligible students may apply through online on the website of common National Scholarship portal of Govt. of India under URL www.scholarships.gov.in as per above given time line. It may be ensured that the students whose annual Fees is less than Rs. 50000/- has no need to upload any documents on the web portal and the student whose fee is more than Rs.50000/- has need to upload all the documents on the NSP portal. It may also be ensured that the students will take printouts of the duly filled application forms and submit along with all supporting documents (i.e. residence proof, last class pass certificate, Aadhaar no., bank account in the name of applicant, income proof Minority certificate/Affidavit) in their respective institutes. It will be necessary for the applicants to provide Aadhaar number/Aadhaar Enrolment ID while applying for the scholarship. Institutes are suggested to verify the applications of the students on NSP portal using their institute User ID and Password, well in time.
