Seat Matrix & Other Important Instructions for MBBS course: -

1. The sequence of the counselling will be for General Category First, then followed by SC Category and OBC (NCL)*** Category seats.
2. The revised seat matrix and distribution of seats are as under: -

- I. **15% seats in UT Chandigarh Pool are reserved for SC Category.**
- II. **27% seats in UT Chandigarh Pool are reserved for OBC (NCL) Category over a staggered period of 6 years as under: -**

*In calculation of percentage of seats for reserved category/categories, the figure has been rounded off to lower whole number if decimal point is less than 0.5 and to higher whole number if the decimal point is 0.5 or more.

**Seats mentioned against Scheduled Caste Category, OBC (NCL) category and General

Category include seats reserved for PwD Candidates. *PwD Candidates will be placed in the category to which they belong and corresponding number of seats will be deducted from the seats mentioned against the respective category i.e. either Scheduled Caste, OBC (NCL) category or General Category.*

Note: - As the candidate, selected against the quota for PwDs must be placed in the appropriate category viz. SC or General or OBC(NCL), depending upon the category to which they belong, therefore, 06 seats from the General Category & number of seats from SC category equal to number of SC PwD applicants will remains on hold till further orders. Further, 03 seats of General Category will also remain on hold till the permission /intimation is received from the NMC/MCC, New Delhi regarding implementation of OBC (NCL) reservation. Therefore, total of 9 seats out of 98 General category seats of UT Pool will remains on hold till further orders.

Seat Matrix & Other Important Instructions for BHMS course: -

It is informed that all the Eligibility Criteria, General conditions and admission process as mentioned in the Centralized Admission Prospectus 2025 for BHMS course, will also apply to the candidates belonging to OBC (NCL) and OBC (NCL) PwD category.
