1. (1) **Short title and commencement.**—(i) These rules may be called the Government Medical College and Hospital, Chandigarh, Driver, Group-'C' (Non-Ministerial) (2nd Amendment) Rules, 2019.

(ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official gazette.
